Most of the workers in brick kiln are internal displaced people by natural disaster, internal conflict of the country and landless. They came from remote and impoverished districts in search of daily labor in order to support their hand-to-mouth existence.

The hazardous work, long hours, meager pay, and unsanitary living conditions combine to pose serious health threats that have gone unaddressed. Their conditions are pathetic. Among the children are countless babies and toddler.

To improve the livelihood of the brick workers since 2006 CDO have started **Mobile Health Clinic and Awareness** for around 4800 to 5000 workers of six brick kilns every year and in 5years 17,164 workers got benefited. Please visit the program <http://caredevelopment.org/5/Mobile-Clinic.php>

With the theme "*Good Health Good Education and Good Children*" CDO start **Children Development Program (CDP)** since 2006 and currently serving 120 children. Its day care centre, where children were provided nutrition foods, regular medical care and non-formal education. This year CDO distributed 130 jackets for the children of brick kilns. Out of them, it was the first time of 30 children to wearing new jacket. They were so excited and overjoyed to receive new jacket that none of the children want to take out even the tag that was put in jacket.
